

Philanthropy is a transformational catalyst that ensures excellence in everything Pomona Valley Hospital Medical Center (PVHMC) provides to their patients and families. Since the Hospital's founding in 1903, the philanthropic support provided by generations of visionary donors and leaders has funded a variety of significant projects and programs. These include The Robert and Beverly Lewis Family Cancer Care Center and the Stead Heart and Vascular Center.

### HEART AND SOUL

For too many years, patients who needed extra care for heart surgery, stroke or other cardiovascular health issues usually had to travel a long distance to downtown Los Angeles. In the early 1980s, physicians and Hospital administration recognized that a leading edge cardiovascular center was needed in this community. Longtime Hospital board member Bill Stead, together with his wife Carole, recognized that making the initial gift to establish this heart center was vital to the success of the project. It would also be a wonderful way to honor Bill's parents for their own service to the Hospital and community. The Steads made their gift, as did hundreds of others, and today the original vision for this cardiovascular center has expanded in phenomenal ways. The Stead Heart and Vascular Center is among the highest overall rated programs in Los Angeles and San Bernardino counties and has received the national 50 Top Cardio Hospital award.

## COMPASSIONATE CANCER CARE CLOSE TO HOME


Robert and Beverly Lewis and their family members knew how important it was to provide patients with a state-of-the-art cancer center close to home. Their initial gift prompted hundreds of others to give, and in 1993 The Robert and Beverly Lewis Family Cancer Care Center opened its doors. Today it provides the latest in cancer treatment, education, support and wellness to our community. The Center's compassionate team truly cares for the whole patient, not just the disease. The team helps calm patients, and provides support to patients and their families every step of the way.

## ADVANCED TECHNOLOGY ADVANCES LIVES

Philanthropic support has also helped fund major purchases of new healthcare technologies. These include Tomosynthesis (ultra-accurate 3D breast imaging), specialized Giraffe OmniBeds and Bi-Level CPAP ventilation equipment for the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit, and new monitoring stations for the Telemetry units. Philanthropic gifts have also helped fund specific Hospital programs like diabetes management (in conjunction with the March of Dimes), nursing education, Baby Friendly training for all nurses in the Women's and Children's Center, and the numerous wellness programs in the cancer center. This includes the *Living Well After Cancer* program, which is provided in collaboration with The Claremont Club.

When you make a gift to PVHMC Foundation, you enhance the lives of countless individuals and families in our community. You give people hope and a sense that others care deeply for them as patients.





## MANY WAYS TO GIVE

- **Outright Gifts** of cash, stock, mutual fund shares, life insurance and other similar items are often the easiest and most convenient way to give. - **Annual and Major Gifts** may be designated for a specific funding purpose or left undesignated, allowing the Hospital administration team to direct funds for priority projects.
- **Foundation Grant Funding** is provided to the PVHMC Foundation from a variety of local and national Foundations. These funds help PVHMC improve the health of the community.


